

Javascript Wait While Loading Page Display Image

If you have a page that takes long time to display it is a good idea to display a "wait until the page loads" image. This tutorial show you how to implement this in your webpage. To implement this you will need to: 1. Every time your page loads a "init()" function will load. `<body onLoad="init()">` 2. Define a div named "loading" right after `<body>` section. `<div id="loading" style="position:absolute; width:100%; text-align:center; top:300px;">`

`</div>`The loading.gif image should be an animated gif that suggests that the page is still loading. 3. Place this javascript code right after you define the div. `<script>`

var Id=(document.all);
var ns4=document.layers;
var ns6=document.getElementById&&!document.all;
var ie4=document.all;
if (ns4)
  Id=document.loading;
else if (ns6)
  Id=document.getElementById("loading").style;
else if (ie4)
  Id=document.all.loading.style;
function init()
{
if(ns4){Id.visibility="hidden";}
else if (ns6||ie4) Id.display="none";
}
</script>
```
